Mountain bike club Gaerne organizes on Saturday, April 05, 2025 in Crespignaga di Maser (TV) at the sports facilities in Via San Giacomo an international XCO C2 race, reserved for UCI categories (Open, Junior male and female), called “22nd Gaerne MTB Trophy” with race ID **174236**.

On Sunday, April 06, 2025 in Crespignaga di Maser (TV) at the sports facilities in Via San Giacomo a national XCO race, reserved for FCI youth categories (male and female Esordienti and Allievi), called “22nd Gaerne MTB Trophy” race ID **174237**.

The international track length is 3,600 meters with 150 meters of elevation gain.

The national track length is 3,100 meters with 130 meters of elevation gain.

The attached map shows the locations of the planned installations for: race secretariat, medical station, showers, doping control, toilets, radio station, team and jury area (start/finish).

Rules

Art. 1 Type of trial

The race is part of international/national calendar and will be run according to UCI regulations and will award the scores shown in the attachment 1.

Art. 2 Participation

The race is included in the calendar:

- International class 2 for the (Open man) Elite and under 23, (Open Women) Elite and under 23 and Junior male and female categories.
- National for the categories esordienti and allievi (male and female)

Art. 3 Registration fee

Entries for UCI categories (Open and Junior) must be received by 01/04/2025 at midnight via registration on "Fattore K" (International race ID 174236) for FCI athletes and on the website (www.mtbclubgaerne.com) for foreign athletes. The cost is €25.00, for all categories to be paid on site at number pickup/ license verification (free for UCI teams).

Entries for Esordienti and Allievi categories must be received by 01/04/2025 at midnight via registration on "Fattore K" (National race ID 174237) for FCI athletes. The cost is €10.00 to be paid on site at number pickup/ license verification.

Registration fees will also be required for non-starters; registered teams will be given the opportunity to report any non-attendance of the athlete, no later than the Wednesday before the race.

The Organizing committee undertakes to promptly notify the non-acceptance of the entry. The formula of silent consent is considered valid.

Art. 4 Accreditation / License Verification

Accreditation and license verification will take place at the secretariat at the sports facilities in Crespignaga di Maser (TV).

For UCI categories (Open and Junior) it will be allowed on Friday, April 04, 2025 from 16:00 to 19:00 and on Saturday, April 05, 2025 from 07:00 until one hour before each individual start.

For the Esordienti and Allievi categories will be allowed on Saturday, April 05, 2025 from 17:00 to 19:00 and Sunday, April 06 from 07:00 until one hour before each individual start.

Art. 4.1 Media accreditation

Application for access to the event as Media must be made through the accreditation form on www.mtbclubgaerne.com no later than 02/04/2025 at midnight

Art. 5 Technical meeting

The technical meeting for all categories will be online.

Art. 6 Formation of starting grids

Grid calling will take place inside the soccer field 15 minutes before each start.

Art. 7 Technical assistance / Feed zone

On the course there will be a double technical assistance/feed zone marked and equipped located near the start/finish area at the top of the hill called "Zoppa Secca". Only accredited personnel will have access (2 passes every 4 athletes).

Art. 8 Medical control

The medical control will be held according to UCI, FCI, and Ministry of Health regulations and will take place at the sports facilities in Crespignaga di Maser (TV).

Art. 9 Showers / Bike wash

Locker rooms with showers will be available for athletes at the sports facilities in Crespignaga di Maser (TV).

Bike washing will be set up outside the soccer field (northwest side).

Art. 10 Rankings

All runners who cross the finish line after the winner will have finished the race and will be ranked according to their position.

A runner who drops out must immediately leave the course and has no right to cross the finish line. He or she will be listed on the finishing order as "DNF" (Did Not Finish), and will not earn any points in that race.

Lapped racers must finish the lap on which they were caught up and leave the stage via an exit located before the last straight. They will be ranked according to the order in which they retired from the race, their name will be indicated on the finishing order with the number of laps they have lagged behind.

The rankings will be transmitted to the FCI and UCI as per current regulations on an Excel sheet.

Art. 11 Award ceremonies

The award ceremony will be held at the end of each race.

Art. 12 Prize money

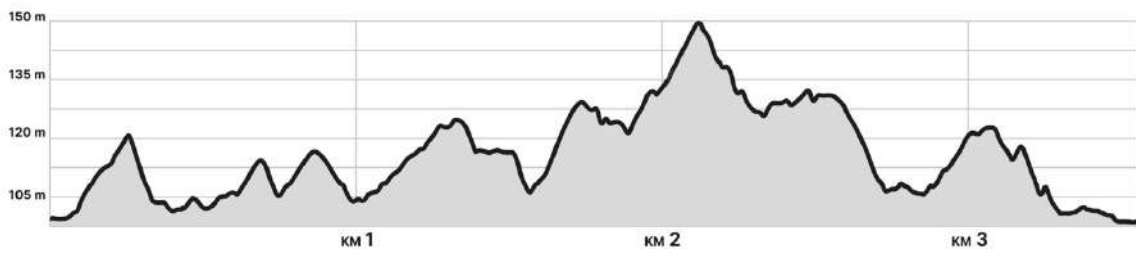

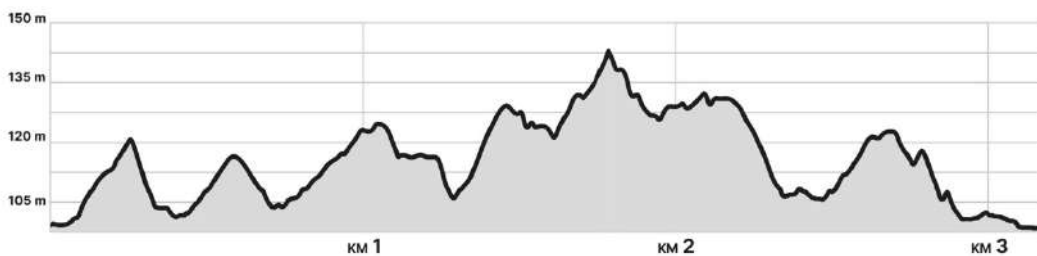


Art. 17.1 Altimetry

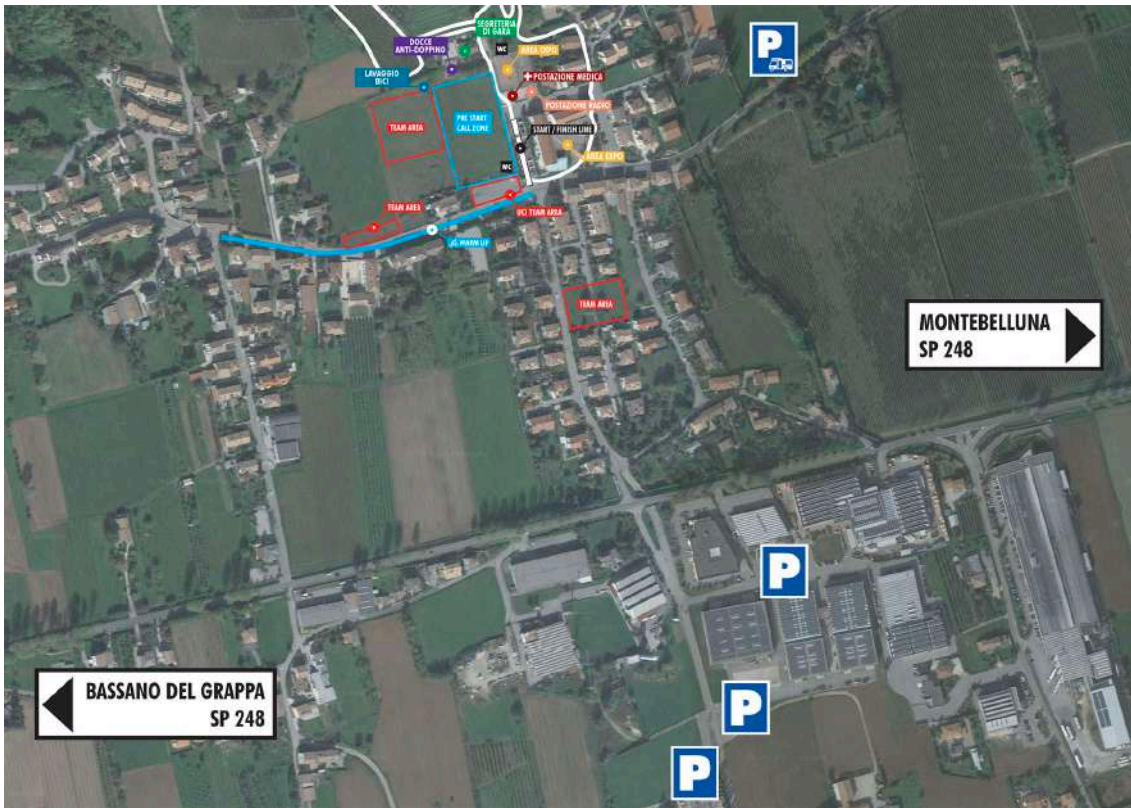

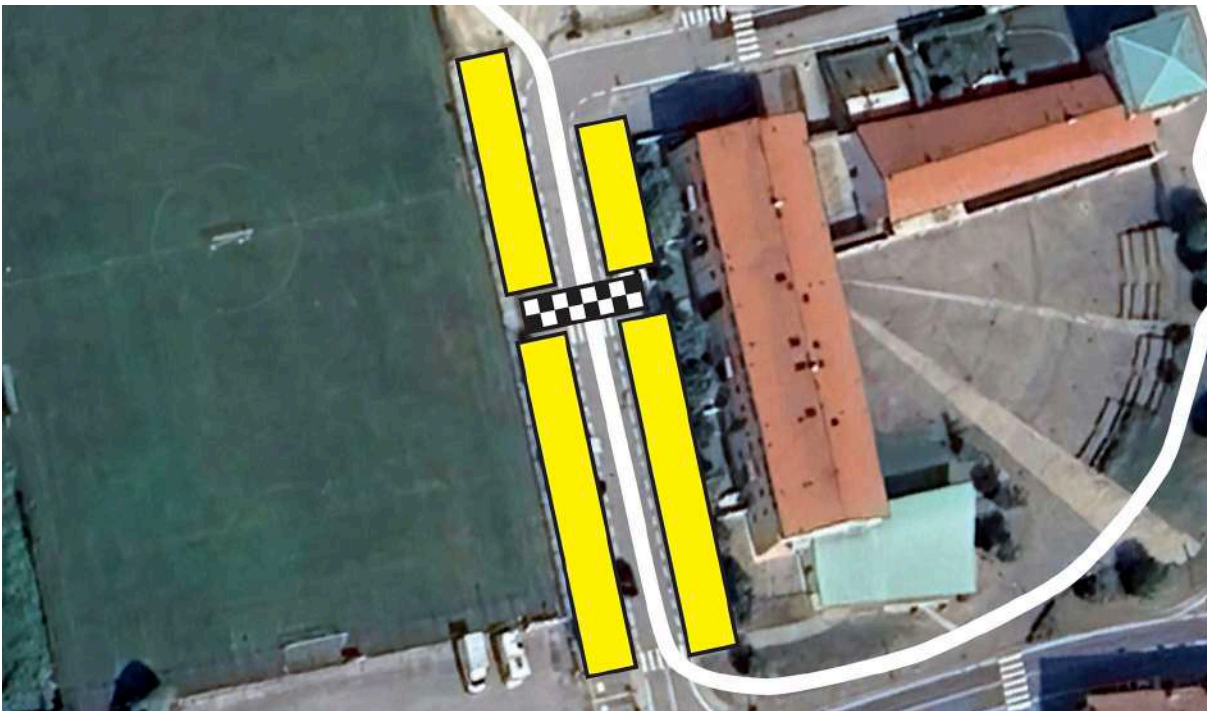

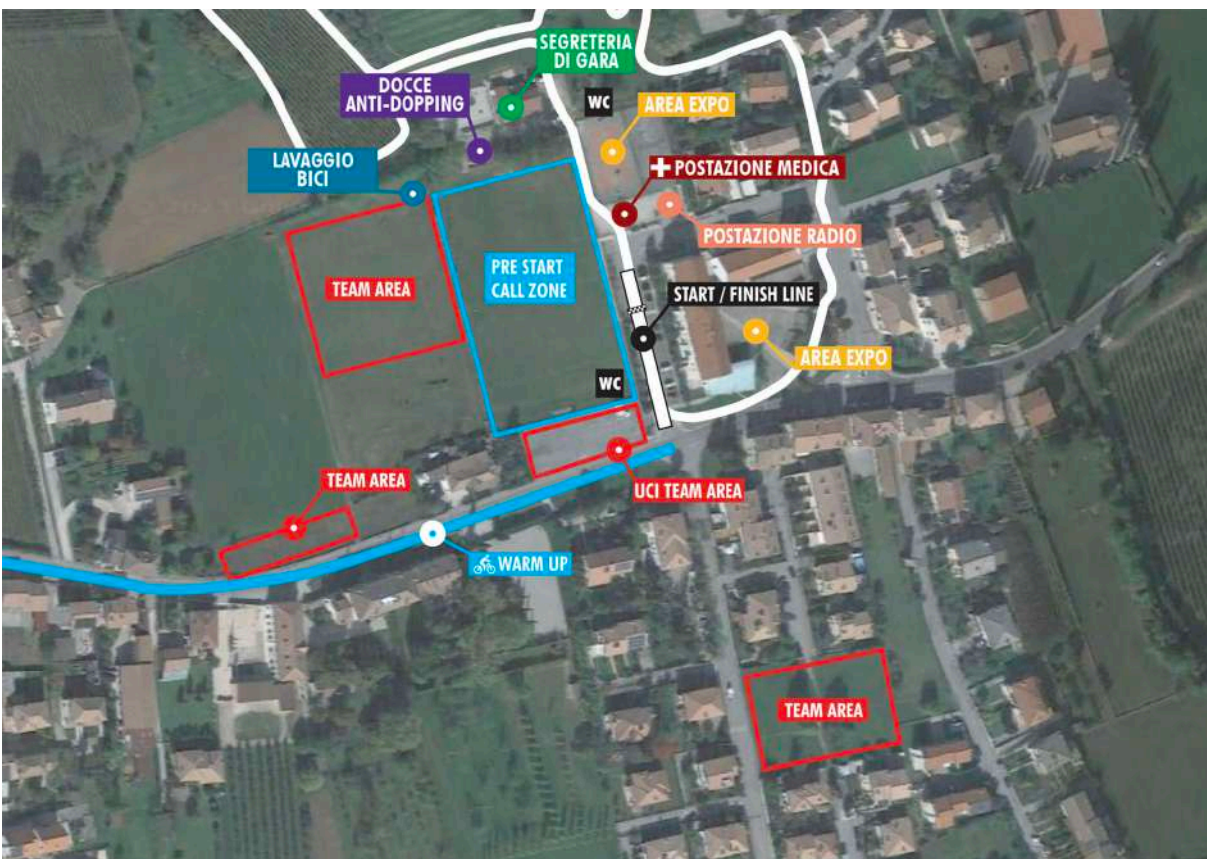

Maser is a municipality in the province of Treviso, Veneto region of about 5,000 residents with an area of 27.5 km² and is located at an altitude of 147 meters above sea level.

The territory is half flat and half hilly, with the highest point (Colle Collalto) at 496 meters above sea level.

Walking through the hills it will be easy to encounter green and floral landscapes. Maser is home to Villa Barbaro, a splendid Palladian masterpiece of 16th-century art.

Maser is also known for its cherries (La Ciliogia di Maser), in April the landscape is bathed in snowy white for their blossoming and in early June offers all the splendor of taste and beauty.

There are also many oil producers in Maser; the hilly area offers fertile soil for olive trees and wine.
